
TEMPERAMENT-Meaning


Temperaments-An evolution


Around 400 B.C Hippocrates first noticed that in addition to having different looks, hair texture, eye colour and body shape, people have unique personalities that sets them apart.



Temperaments-An evolution

He identified four body fluids blood, yellow bile, philegm and black bile that he believed accounted for differences in individuals.





Centuries later around 149 A.D., Galen proposed a temperament theory built on Hippocrates observation. According to Galen there were four basic human temperaments; sanguine, choleric, melancholic and phlegmatic. These temperament types were categorized depending on the amount of certain bodily fluids that were in persons body.

Characterized by light complexion, full pulse, optimistic out look and quick but not lasting temper.






A temperament characterized by a quick irritable temper

Cholerics do not readily reveal deep emotions except anger. Cholerics are often accused of being stubborn, domineering, and dictatorial.




The choleric is your original "type A" personality. This temperament is characterized by quick, intense reactions to both external and internal stimuli.


